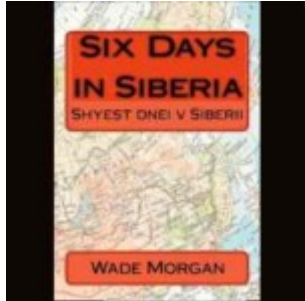


Tahoe author to talk about book on Siberia



Local author Bill Morgan (pen name Wade Morgan) will be discussing his book "Six Days in Siberia", a suspense thriller with overtones of a spy novel, on Oct. 1.
