

Domestic violence suspect apprehended

A Truckee man wanted on domestic violence and other charges was arrested Aug. 8.

Corbin Nunnally, 30, was wanted for his possible involvement in several felonies including domestic violence, kidnapping, child endangerment and robbery.

Truckee officers tried to apprehend Nunnally at the Gateway shopping center on Donner Pass Road on Aug. 6

Truckee PD received information from the Reno Police Department that Nunnally had boarded a bus headed to the Sacramento area. In conjunction with the Reno PD, surveillance was established on the bus and law enforcement followed the bus to California. The Truckee Police Department and California Highway Patrol conducted a traffic stop on the bus on Interstate 80 near Hirschdale Road.

Nunnally was taken into custody without incident. He was booked in to the jail in Truckee on charges of kidnapping, dissuading a victim from reporting a crime with threats, burglary, child endangerment and criminal threats.
