In order to become an "adjudicated publication"  $\bar{L}TN$  must jump through several legal hoops. That's where you come into play. We need paid subscribers. Don't worry – it won't break the bank, it might help clear the couch of that long forgotten pocket change residing there. Although LTN will remain available even if you don't contribute, a minimum \$1 per year (the maximum is up to you) would allow us to add you to our "paid" subscribers list (one of the required legal hoops described above) and secure our designation as an "adjudicated publication" as well as LTN's future.
