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## **SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE**

### **Sunday through Saturday, August 10 - 16, 2014**

#### **LONG-TERM PROJECTS**

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra: Work is set to begin on the \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance for nine structures in south Placer County. The vertical clearance will be increase on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down to a lower level.

#### **August 1 through October 1**

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Rollins Lake Road/Magra Road (Exit 139): Westbound motorists can expect a long-term closure of the on and off-ramps from **August 1 through October 1**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous structure work. **Motorists are advised to Secret Town interchange as the alternate route.**

#### **SHORT-TERM PROJECTS**

**State Route 49** (Yuba and Sierra Counties) from Willow Creek Campground to Yuba Summit: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control at various locations from **7:15 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to miscellaneous maintenance work.

**State Route 49** (Nevada County) from Fawn Path Drive to Alta Sierra Drive: Motorists can expect the #1 lanes closed from **9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to guardrail work.





**State Route 49** (Placer County) from Elm Avenue/Fulwiler Avenue to Lincoln Way in Auburn: Motorists can expect the #2 lanes closed from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to utility work.

**State Route 49** (Placer County) from the American River Bridge to the Ranger Station in the Auburn Ravine: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **24/7 from August 1 through August 12**. A contractor is scheduled to do cement barrier work.

**Interstate 80** (Sierra and Nevada Counties) from the Nevada State line to Farad: Westbound motorists can expect the #2 lane closed from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do drainage work.

**Interstate 80** (Nevada County) from Fiberboard undercrossing to the Truckee Scales: Motorists can expect the eastbound #2 lanes closed from **7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

**Interstate 80** (Nevada County) from end of Chain on area to the Hinton Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect the eastbound #1 lane closed from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do drainage work.

**Interstate 80** (Nevada County) from Floriston to Hinton: Motorists can expect the westbound #2 lanes closed from **5 p.m. to 9 a.m. Wednesday and Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do grinding operations.

**Interstate 80** (Nevada County) at Soda Springs: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #1 lanes closed from **midnight Monday through 3 p.m. Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Weimar Cross Road to Placer Hills Road: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #1 lanes closed from **7 p.m. to 8 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Elm Avenue to Russell Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from **9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

**State Route 89** (Placer County) from State Route 28 to Alpine Meadows: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **10 p.m. to 8 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.





**State Route 267** (Nevada County) from Interstate 80 to Soaring Way/Brockway Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from **9 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from at the Newcastle Tunnel: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **July 29 through August 21**. A contractor is scheduled to do highway construction. **Vehicles in excess of 41 feet are prohibited.**

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
