SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE
Sunday through Saturday, September 14 - 20, 2014

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra: Work is set to begin on the \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance for nine structures in south Placer County. The vertical clearance will be increase on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down to a lower level.

August 1 through October 31

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Rollins Lake Road/Magra Road (Exit 139): Westbound motorists can expect a long-term closure of the on and off-ramps from **August 1 through October 31**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous structure work. **Motorists are advised to Secret Town interchange as the alternate route.**

September 14 - 19

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Penryn Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous structure work.

September 14 - 19

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Magra Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from **7 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous structure work.





September 18 - 19

Interstate 80 (Placer County) on Rollins Lake Road/Magra Road: Motorists can one-way traffic controls on the local overcrossing of Interstate 80 from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Thursday and Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous structure work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Brunswick to Idaho Maryland Road: Motorists can various lane and ramp restrictions from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Slate Range Road to Gold Lake Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control at various locations from **7:15 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Indian Flat Road to Old Downieville Highway: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do tree work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Elm-Harrison Street to Joeger Road: Motorists can expect various north and southbound lanes closed from **9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to paving and sweeping work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Fiberboard undercrossing to the Truckee Scales: Motorists can expect the eastbound #1 lanes closed from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from end of Chain on area to the Hinton Road undercrossing: Motorists can expect the eastbound #1 lane closed from **8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Floriston to Hinton: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #1 lanes closed from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.





Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Vista Point to Donner Lake undercrossing: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #1 lanes closed from **5 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Acid Flats to Farad: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #2 lanes closed from **5 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at Soda Springs: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #1 lanes closed from **midnight Monday through 8 a.m. Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Kingvale to Whitmore: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do drainage work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Weimar Cross Road to Placer Hills Road: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #1 lanes closed from **7 p.m. to 9 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Elm Avenue to Russell Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from **7 p.m. to 9 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Calpine Summit to the Plumas County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Pole Creek Road to Goose Meadows Campground: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday and Wednesday**. A Caltrans Crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) at Perry Creek: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday and Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do bridge work.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Prasser Dam Road/Alder Drive to Alder Creek Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do drainage work.





State Route 267 (Nevada County) from Interstate 80 to Soaring Way/Brockway Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from **8 p.m. to 8 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.
