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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Monday through Saturday, January 5-10, 2015

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. Jan. 5-10

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Monday through Friday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn, Gilardi and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Dry Creek Road to Clipper Gap: Eastbound motorists can expect the #3 lane closed from 7 p.m. to 11 p.m. Monday for electrical work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Applegate Road to Dry Creek Road: Westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **11 p.m. Monday to 3 a.m. Tuesday** for electrical work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from the El Dorado County line to Borland Avenue/Lincoln Way in Auburn: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Tuesday, Thursday and Friday** for drainage work.





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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
