Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, March 15-21

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. <u> March 15-21</u>

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

<u> March 15</u>

Gilardi Road Overcrossing (Placer County) Motorists can expect the overcrossing closed **through Sunday March 15**.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (Yuba and Sierra counties) between Marysville Road in Auburn to Downieville: Motorists can expect lane closures at various times and locations from **8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday** for miscellaneous work.
