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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, April 19-25

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. April 19-April 25

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

April 19 – May 6

Horseshoe Bar Road Overcrossing (Placer County) Motorists can expect the overcrossing closed from **Sunday, April 19 through Wednesday May 6.**

April 21-22

Interstate 80 (Placer County) between Sierra College Boulevard and State Route 193 junction; Motorists can expect full highway closure with an eight-mile detour from **11 p.m. Tuesday to 5 a.m. Wednesday**. The interstate will be closed again from **11 p.m. Wednesday, March 4 until 5 a.m. Thursday** for the raising of the Horseshoe Bar Road Overcrossing.



State Route 89 (Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Ground breaking on April 2 to officially begin project to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

April 19 – 25

No work is scheduled for this week on the project.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada/Placer County) from the Kingvale Undercrossing to the Yuba Gap Overcrossing: Motorists can expect lane closures at various locations from **7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday** for guardrail repair.

Interstate 80 - Westbound (Nevada/Placer Counties) from the Donner Lake Road interchange to the Kingvale Undercrossing: Motorists can expect lane closures at various locations from **7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday** for guardrail repair.

Interstate 80 - Westbound (Placer Counties) from the Interstate 80/State Route 193 interchange to the Hallbom Road undercrossing (Werner Road): Motorists can expect lane closures at various locations from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday** for bridge work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from Hinton Road to the Truckee River Bridge #13: Motorists can expect lane closures from **5 a.m. to 8 p.m. Wednesday April 22 through Friday April 24** for grinding operations.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from Farad Undercrossing to the Truckee River Bridge #13: Motorists can expect lane closures from **5 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday April 20 through Thursday April 23** for grinding operations.



Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) at the Central Truckee undercrossing: Motorists can expect partial ramp closure from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Wednesday, April 22** for electrical work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) from the State Route 174/Interstate 80 separator to the Secret Town overcrossing: Motorists can expect lane closures and shoulder restrictions from **7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Tuesday, April 21 and Wednesday, April 22** for survey work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) at the Soda Springs overcrossing: Motorists can expect lane closures and right shoulder restrictions **7 a.m. to 11 a.m. Tuesday April 21 through Friday April 24** for curb, gutter and sidewalk work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) between Old Auburn Road and Alta Sierra Drive: Motorists can expect lane closures **9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, April 20** for drainage cleaning.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
