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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, July 5 – July 11

Most traffic interfering work will be limited between Thursday, July 2 through Sunday, July 5 due to the 4th of July Holiday

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. July 5 – July 11

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Ground breaking on April 2 to officially begin project to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls through the tunnel from **6 p.m. to 10 a.m. Monday July 6 through Friday July 10** for roadway excavation.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 – (Placer County) at the Illinoistown Overcrossing at Canyon Way and South Auburn Street/Placer Hills Road: Motorists can expect alternating **daytime** and **overnight** overcrossing lane and freeway connector ramp closures from **5 a.m. Monday July 6 through 5 p.m. Friday July 10** for roadway excavation and bridge work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) at the Kingvale Onramp: Motorists can expect full connector ramp closure from **Midnight Monday July 6 through 11 a.m. Friday July 10** for highway construction.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer/Nevada County) from the Kingvale Undercrossing to the Donner Lake Road interchange: Motorists can expect right lane and both right and left shoulder closures from **12:01 a.m. to 11 a.m. Monday July 6 and from 5 p.m. Monday July 6 through 11 a.m. Friday July 10** for highway construction.

Interstate 80 – (Nevada County) between Hirschdale Road and Mystic Road/Farad undercrossing: Motorists can expect intermittent overnight connector ramp closures and various alternating lane closures from **6 a.m. Monday July 6 through 11 a.m. Friday July 10** for grinding operations and bridge work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) at the Highway 89 South interchange: Motorists can expect full connector ramp closure from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday July 7 through Thursday July 9** for shoulder work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Rio Oso Road to SR 49 / SR 20 interchange: Motorists can expect alternating lane and shoulder closures from **9 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Monday July 6 through 6 a.m. Friday July 10** for grinding and paving work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) Northbound and Southbound McKnight Way: Motorists can expect connector ramp closures from **9 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Monday July 6 through 6 a.m. Friday July 10** for grinding and paving work.



State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Loganville Camp Ground to Yuba Pass: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday July 6 through Thursday July 9** for ditch cleaning.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Donner Creek to Donner Pass Road (under the I-80 interchange): Motorists can expect right lane closure from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday July 7 through Thursday July 9** for shoulder work.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Prosser Dam Road to Sage Hen Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **5 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesday July 7 through 2 p.m. Friday July 10** for AC Paving.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Cold Creek Campground to Old Truckee Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **Noon to 5 p.m. Tuesday July 7 and Wednesday July 8** for core drilling.

Special Events

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) at the Central Truckee exit # 186: Both connector ramps will be closed from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. for the Town of Truckee's Annual 4th of July Parade on Donner Pass Road from SR 89 to Bridge Street in downtown. Eastbound motorists may use the Central Truckee exit but will be immediately detoured onto West River Street.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
