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## Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, August 30 – September 5

**Roadwork will end, project schedule permitting, at Noon Friday September 4 and will not resume until 8 p.m. Tuesday, September 8 for the Labor Day Holiday**

### LONG-TERM PROJECTS

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on six structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other three will have the roadway below dug down. #### **August 30 – September 5**

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Friday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work. (Labor Day holiday restrictions in effect)

**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Nicknamed the “Mousehole” project, work continues to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

#### **August 30 – September 5**



**State Route 89** (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls through the tunnel and right shoulder closures from **4 a.m. to 10 a.m. Monday August 31 through Friday September 4** for concrete pour.

### SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) at the Illinoistown Overcrossing at Canyon Way and South Auburn Street/Placer Hills Road: Motorists can expect freeway connector ramp closures **Monday August 31 and Tuesday September 1 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.** for paving operations and bridge work. Motorists can also expect intermittent one-way traffic controls across the Illinoistown Overcrossing **Monday August 31 and Tuesday September 1 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.** for roadway excavation and bridge work.

**Interstate 80** (Placer County) from the Bowman Road undercrossing to the Haines Road (Bell Road) overcrossing: Motorists can expect overnight lane and shoulder restrictions from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. (westbound) and 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. (eastbound) Monday August 31 through 7 a.m. Friday September 4** for bridge work.

**Interstate 80** (Nevada County) between Floriston and the Farad undercrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **6 a.m. to 11 a.m. Friday September 4** for the removal of scaffolding from Acid Flat Bridge.

**Interstate 80 – Westbound** (Nevada County) at the Floriston Road interchange: Motorists can expect full ramp closure from **6 p.m. Sunday August 30 to 9 a.m. Monday August 31** for striping operations.

**Interstate 80 – Westbound** (Nevada County) from the Floriston interchange to the Truckee River Bridge #12: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **5 p.m. to 9 a.m. beginning Tuesday September 1 through 9 a.m. Friday September 4** for striping operations.

**Interstate 80 – Westbound** (Placer County) from the Blue Canyon Road undercrossing to the Gold Run overcrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane and right shoulder closures from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday August 31 to Thursday September 3** for shoulder work.

**Interstate 80 - Westbound** (Placer/Nevada County) from the Kingvale Undercrossing to the Donner Lake Road interchange: Motorists can expect right



lane and both right and left shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday August 31 through Thursday September 3** for drainage repairs.

**Interstate 80 – Eastbound** (Placer/Nevada County) from the Kingvale Undercrossing to the Soda Springs Off-Ramp: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from **5 p.m. to 11 a.m. Monday August 31 through Friday September 4** for highway construction.

**Interstate 80 – Eastbound** (Placer/Nevada County) from the Yuba Gap Overcrossing to the Donner Lake Road interchange: Motorists can expect right lane, right and left shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday August 31 through Thursday September 3** for drainage repairs.

**Interstate 80 – Eastbound** (Placer County) at the Kingvale overcrossing: Motorists can expect full ramp closure from **7 p.m. to 5 p.m. Monday August 31 to Thursday September 3 and from 7 p.m. Thursday to Noon Friday September 4** for highway construction.

**Interstate 80 – Eastbound** (Nevada County) through the Chain-Off Area east of the Truckee River Bridge: Motorists can expect right lane and right shoulder closures from **7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Thursday September 4** for shoulder work.

**Interstate 80 – Eastbound** (Nevada County) from the Truckee River Bridge #12 to the Acid Flat Bridge: Motorists can expect alternating lane and shoulder closures **7 p.m. to Noon Sunday August 30 through Thursday September 3 and from 7 p.m. Thursday to 9 a.m. Friday September 4** for striping work.

**Interstate 80 – Eastbound** (Nevada County) at the Hirschdale Road Interchange: Motorists can expect full ramp closure from **9 p.m. Tuesday September 1 to 5 a.m. Wednesday September 2** for striping operations.

**State Route 49 - Southbound** (Placer County) from Willow Creek Drive to Bell Road: Motorists can expect overnight right lane and right shoulder closures from **9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday September 1 through Friday morning September 4** for pavement work.

**State Route 49** (Nevada County) from Rio Oso Road to SR 49 / SR 20 interchange: Motorists can expect alternating lane, auxiliary lane and shoulder closures from **9 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday August 30 through Sunday September 6** for grinding and paving work.



**State Route 49** (Nevada County) at the junction of State Route 49 and State Route 20 (West Empire Street): Motorists can expect connector ramp closures from **10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday August 30 through Friday September 4** for grinding and paving work.

**State Route 49** (Nevada County) Northbound and Southbound McKnight Way: Motorists can expect connector ramp closures from **10 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday August 30 through Sunday September 6** for grinding and paving work.

**State Route 49** (Sierra County) from Oak Valley (Yuba/Sierra County line) to Yuba Pass: Motorists can expect intermittent one way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday August 31 through Friday September 4** for maintenance work.

**State Route 49** (Sierra County) from Lemon Canyon/Campbell Hot Springs to Filippini Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic operations from **6 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday August 31 through Friday September 4** for drainage work.

**State Route 89** (Sierra County) from Perry Creek (Sierraville) to Berry Creek (Sierra/Plumas county line): Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday August 31 through Thursday September 3** for drainage work.

**State Route 89** (Nevada County) from Prosser Dam Road to Sage Hen Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **5 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday August 31 through Thursday September 3** for AC paving and guardrail repair.

**State Route 89** (Placer County) from Squaw Valley Road to Montreal Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday August 31 to Thursday September 3** for ditch cleaning.

**State Route 193** (Placer County) from County Road P57 to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday August 31 through Thursday September 3** for utility work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
