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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, November 8 – November 14

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. November 8 – November 14

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Nicknamed the “Mousehole” project, work continues to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR 89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

November 8 – November 14

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: No traffic interfering work scheduled for this week.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS





Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) at the Gold Run Safety Rest Area: Motorists can expect the rest area to be closed from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday November 10** for sewer work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Placer County) at the Gold Run Safety Rest Area: Motorists can expect the rest area to be closed from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday November 12** for sewer work.

State Route 20 – Westbound (Nevada County) from the WB off-ramp to Bennett Street to the Hwy 174 junction: Motorists can expect the ramp's left turn lane and one lane on the surface street to be closed from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday November 9 - 13** for utility work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Cameo Drive to Mother Lode/Oak Drive: Motorists can expect overnight intermittent alternating lane, auxiliary lane, median and shoulder closures from **11 p.m. Saturday November 7 to 7 a.m. Sunday November 8** for striping work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) at the McKnight Way interchange: Motorists can expect alternating northbound and southbound full ramp closures from **10 p.m. Saturday November 7 to 9 a.m. Sunday November 8** for striping work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) at the Hwy 49/20 West Empire Street interchange: Motorists can expect alternating northbound and southbound full ramp closures from **10 p.m. Saturday November 7 to 9 a.m. Sunday November 8** for striping work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Lime Kiln Road to Coyote Street: Motorists can expect overnight intermittent alternating lane, auxiliary lane, median and shoulder closures from **10 p.m. Saturday November 7 to 9 a.m. Sunday November 8** for striping work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Newtown Road to Lowden Lane: Motorists can expect alternating lane, median and right shoulder closures from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday November 9 through Friday November 13** for drainage work.

State Route 49 (Yuba/Sierra County) from Sleighville Circle to the Downie River: Motorists can expect intermittent one way traffic controls from **8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday and Tuesday November 9 & 10 and Thursday and Friday November 12 & 13** for crack seal work.





State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Prosser Dam Road to Sage Hen Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **5 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday November 9, Thursday November 12 and through 2 p.m. Friday November 13** for AC paving work.

State Route 174 – Eastbound (Nevada County) from Oak Street to Gold Hill Drive: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday November 9-13** for utility work.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) from Clark Street to Auburn Street: Motorists can expect westbound lane closure with detour from **6 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday November 9 through 5 a.m. Friday November 13** for utility work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
