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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, December 6 – December 12

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. December 6 – December 12

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Horseshoe Bar Road interchange: Motorists can expect intermittent on and off ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Saturday December 5 through 7 a.m. Saturday December 12** for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Newcastle Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect intermittent on and off ramp closures from **10 p.m. to 7 a.m. Saturday December 5 through 7 a.m. Sunday December 6** for bridge work

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) at the Union Pacific Railroad undercrossing south of Interstate 80: Nicknamed the “Mousehole” project, work continues to construct a pedestrian and bicycle tunnel under the Union Pacific Railroad adjacent to the existing SR



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89 undercrossing and construct a Class I paved trail along the east side of SR 89 between Deerfield Drive and West River Street.

December 6 – December 12

State Route 89 (Placer/Nevada County) from West River Street to Deerfield Drive: No traffic interfering work scheduled for this week.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Soda Springs overcrossing: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls on the local cross-street on **Monday December 7 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.** for utility work.

Interstate 80 - Eastbound (Placer County) from North Long Ravine Union Pacific overcrossing to Magra overcrossing (Rollins Lake Road): Motorists can expect right lane closures from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Thursday December 10** for tree work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Placer County) from the Cape Horn undercrossing to the Magra overcrossing: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures, median, left and right shoulder closures from **7 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday December 6 through 9 a.m. Thursday December 10** for bridge work.

State Route 49 (Yuba/Sierra County) from Marysville Road to the Yuba Pass Campground: Motorists can expect alternating lane closures from **8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday December 7 - 11** for miscellaneous work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from County Road P57 to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect alternating lane and right shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday December 7 - 12** for utility work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
