Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, May 1, 2016 – May 7, 2016

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. May 1 – May 7, 2016

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday** for bridge work. Motorists also can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Brace, Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, King, Penryn and Magra overcrossings for bridge work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Lager Beer Viaduct to .35 miles north of Lager Beer Viaduct: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for lane closures from **7 a.m. to 3 p.m. until May 6** for retaining wall construction.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from Hwy 20 junction to Placer County line: Motorists can expect right lane closures from **9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday May 3** for bridge work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Placer County) from Baxter overcrossing to Gold Run overcrossing: Motorists can expect right lane closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday May 2** for crack seal operations.





Interstate 80 – Westbound (Placer County) from Hampshire Rocks/Rainbow undercrossing to Cisco overcrossing: Motorists can expect right lane closures from **9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday May 2** for bridge work.

State Route 49 (Yuba/Sierra County) from Marysville Road to Yuba Pass summit: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for lane and shoulder closures from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday May 2 through Friday May 6** for miscellaneous work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Hwy 20 interchange to South Fork Yuba River Bridge: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for lane, median and shoulder closures **24-hours around the clock Monday May 2 through Friday May 6 at 6 p.m.** for pavement repair.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Dry Creek Road to Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect right lane restrictions from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday May 2 and Tuesday May 3** for miscellaneous work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Old Truckee Road to Forestry Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday May 2 through Friday May 6** for crack seal operations.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Fowler Lane to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect lane closures (one way traffic control) and right shoulder restrictions **24-hours around the clock Monday May 2 through Friday May 6 at midnight** for highway construction.

State Route 193 (Placer County) Dutch Court to Old State Highway: Motorists can expect lane closures (one way traffic control) and right shoulder restrictions from **8 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Wednesday May 2-4** for utility work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) Sierra College Boulevard to Gold Hill Road: Motorists can expect lane closures (one way traffic control) and right shoulder restrictions from **8 a.m. to 7 p.m. Thursday and Friday May 5 & 6** for utility work.

The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
