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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, August 21-27, 2016

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Brace Road to Magra Road: Work continues on a \$36 million project to increase the vertical clearance of nine bridge structures in south Placer County to 16 feet, 6 inches. The vertical clearance will be increased on seven structures by lifting the existing bridge deck and the other two will have the roadway below dug down. August 21-27

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Newcastle Road: Eastbound and westbound motorists can expect alternating lane closures and on-ramp closures from **10 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday** for bridge and paving work, specifically the Newcastle Road ramps. Motorists also can expect occasional one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday** on the Gilardi, Horseshoe Bar, Penryn, and Newcastle overcrossings for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Long Ravine underpass to .2 miles east of Magra Road overcrossing: Roadwork begins for the 2.5 year, \$50.6 million project to construct @ 3 miles of additional 'truck climbing lane' and other improvements to primarily eastbound I-80 east of Colfax including widening the Cape Horn undercrossing bridge.

August 21-27

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Cape Horn Undercrossing Bridge: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for **around-the-clock** alternating lane closures from **June 20 throughout the summer** for bridge work.





State Route 49 (Sierra County) south of Indian Valley Road: Emergency roadwork will be closing one lane from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. until September 23** for retaining wall construction.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from White Cloud Campground to Washington Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday August 22-26** for drainage work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Mack Road to Crestview Drive: Motorists can expect overnight, one way traffic control for right lane and shoulder closures from **8 p.m. 6 a.m. Monday through Friday August 22- 26** for guardrail work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Oak Valley Road to Yuba Pass Summit: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday August 22-25** for miscellaneous work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Sierraville Creek to Lemon Canyon/Campbell Hot Springs: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday August 22** for crack seal operations.

Interstate 80 - Eastbound (Nevada County) from the CHP Truck Scales to the Twin Bridges/Truckee River: Motorists can expect right lane and shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday August 22** for drainage work.

Interstate 80 - Eastbound (Nevada County) at the Floriston Bridge: Motorists can expect right lane and shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday August 22** for bridge work.

Interstate 80 – Eastbound (Nevada County) from the Acid Flat Bridge to Mystic/Sierra County line: Motorists can expect right lane and shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday August 25** for guardrail repair.

Interstate 80 - Westbound (Nevada County) from the Farad undercrossing to the Acid Flat Bridge/Truckee River: Motorists can expect right lane and shoulder closures from **10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Tuesday August 23** for miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 – Westbound (Nevada County) from the Nevada/Sierra County line to Mystic: Motorists can expect right lane and shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesday August 24** for fence work.





State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Sierraville to Sattley: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday August 22-26** for utility work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Sattley to Fletcher Creek Bridge: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. August 23-25** for drainage operations.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Squaw Creek to Cabin Creek Road: Motorists can expect a moving one way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday and Wednesday August 24 & 25** for grinding and paving operations.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Goose Meadows Campground to Cabin Creek Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday August 23** for drainage work.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Granite Flat Camp to West River Street: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday August 23** for drainage work.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) from Central Avenue to Henderson Street: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday August 23** for pavement repair.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Fowler Road to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect around the clock, 24-hour one way traffic control and right shoulder restrictions from **6 a.m. Monday August 22 to 6 a.m. Saturday August 27** for highway construction.

State Route 267 (Placer County) from Northstar Drive to Martis Peak Road: Motorists can expect intermittent right lane, auxiliary lane and shoulder closures from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday August 22-26** for utility work.

State Route 267 (Nevada County) from Brockway Road/Soaring Way to the Placer County line: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday August 22** for drainage work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
