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Sierra Roadwork Schedule, Sunday through Saturday, February 5-11, 2017

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Long Ravine underpass to .2 miles east of Magra Road overcrossing: Roadwork begins for the 2.5 year, \$50.6 million project to construct @ 3 miles of additional 'truck climbing lane' and other improvements to primarily eastbound I-80 east of Colfax including widening the Cape Horn undercrossing bridge.

February 5-11

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Cape Horn Undercrossing Bridge: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls for **around-the-clock** alternating lane closures from **June 20 throughout the winter** for bridge work.

Interstate 80/State Route 20 (Placer & Nevada Counties) from Magra to Kingvale (I-80) and Yuba Pass (I-80/Hwy 20 interchange) to Willow Valley on SR 20: Governor's drought-related state of emergency declaration includes removal of dying, dead and hazardous trees damaged by bark beetle infestations and other drought-related causes. The projects will improve motorist safety, as well as reduce fuel for potential fires.

February 5-11

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Harmony Ridge to Deer Creek Bridge: Motorists can expect intermittent one way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Friday Feb. 6-10** for tree work.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) at the Coyote/Washington Street interchange: Motorists can expect intermittent full ramp closures from **8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday Feb. 6-10** for landscape work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Sacramento Street overcrossing to Uren Street/Hwy 49 junction: Motorists can expect right lane, auxiliary lane and right shoulder closures from **8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday Feb. 6-10** for landscape work.

State Route 20 - Westbound (Nevada County) at Broad Street: Motorists can expect full ramp closure on the westbound SR 20 on-ramp from **8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Friday Feb. 6-10** for landscape work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Shoshoni Trail to Garesio Ranch Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday Feb. 6-10** for slide removal work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Brandy City Road to Nevada Drive: Motorists can expect intermittent one way traffic controls from **8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday Feb. 6-10** for miscellaneous work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) at Shale Ridge Road: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday Feb. 6-11** for utility work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at the Nevada Street overcrossing (Maple St. and Placer St): Motorists can expect right shoulder closures (on local cross street) from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday Feb. 6-11** for utility work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Roseville Parkway overcrossing: Motorists can expect overnight left lane closures on the local cross street from **9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday night through Friday morning Feb. 6-11** for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the Illinoistown overcrossing/Canyon Way to Weimar Cross Road: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday Jan. 30 - Feb. 3** for culvert replacement operations.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) from Mosswood Lane to Greenhorn Access Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Wednesday Feb. 6-8** for utility work.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) from Gold Hill Drive to Oak Street: Motorists can expect right shoulder closures from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday through Friday Feb. 7-10** for utility work.



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State Route 174 (Placer County) from Long Ravine Road to Old Grass Valley Road: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **9:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday through Saturday Feb. 5-12** for slide removal.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Summer Star/Armes Lane to Skyview Lane: Motorists can expect one way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Wednesday Feb. 6-8** for utility work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divider (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
